 - f. <u>Spirit Wear:</u> Dawn Stiles has agreed to continue to run spirit wear sales per prior discussion with Melissa Warren. Melissa will ask Dawn to contact local businesses for pricing. Line Item to be set at \$100 pending approval.

- g. <u>Fall Festival:</u> Lynne to check with Thelma Von Alt regarding chairing this activity as she has done such in the past. As of this time, chair position remains open for this activity.
- h. <u>McTeacher Night</u>: discussed utilizing other restaurants and change name to Dinner night. Chair position remains open. Will create new committee for Dinner night.
